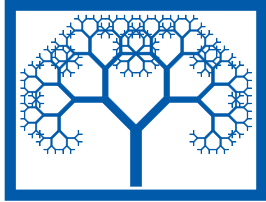

Young Researcher's Paper Prize

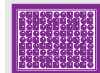
